Bottom Line Up Front

- EVs sales are surging in Vietnam
 - 45% of new car sales in 2026
- VinFast is the dominant player in the EV Space
 - VF3
 - VF5
 - VF7
 - And other models not seen in Canada
- Most scooters and small motorbikes are ICE
 - Incremental change is happening



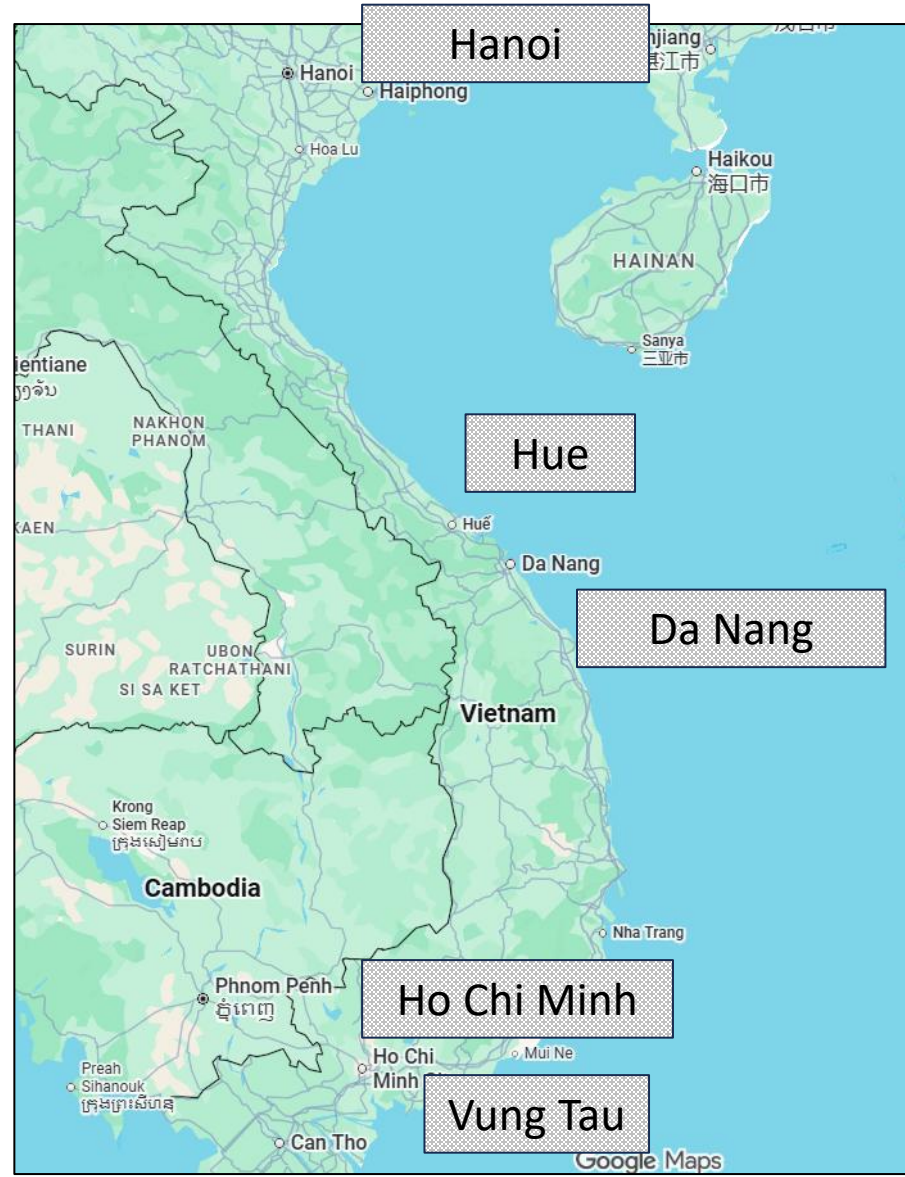
Vietnam Background

- 103 million population 2026
- 527 Billion 2026 GDP (USD)
- Vietnam is rapidly growing economy 5 -11% in recent years
- Scooters & small motorbikes primary form of personal transport
- Huge international airport in Saigon opening 2026
- Ground broken on high-speed rail connecting Hanoi & Saigon
 - 1541 kms
 - 23 stations
 - 67 billion (USD)
- Lack of Public transportation
 - Subways in Hanoi & Saigon city being built at breakneck speed
- Highway system is at an intermediate level and growing fast



Cities visited

- Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) ~ 12 million
- Da Nang ~ 3 million
- Hue ~ 650 K
- Vung Tau ~ 460 K





Observations

- Appeared 30% of cars were EVs
- Vast majority of EVs were VinFast - their charging network dominate
- 50% of Grab rides were in VinFast VF5s & VF e34s
- One ride in BYD
- One Mach E spotted
- Very few BYDs and MGs seen
- No Teslas - prohibitive tariffs

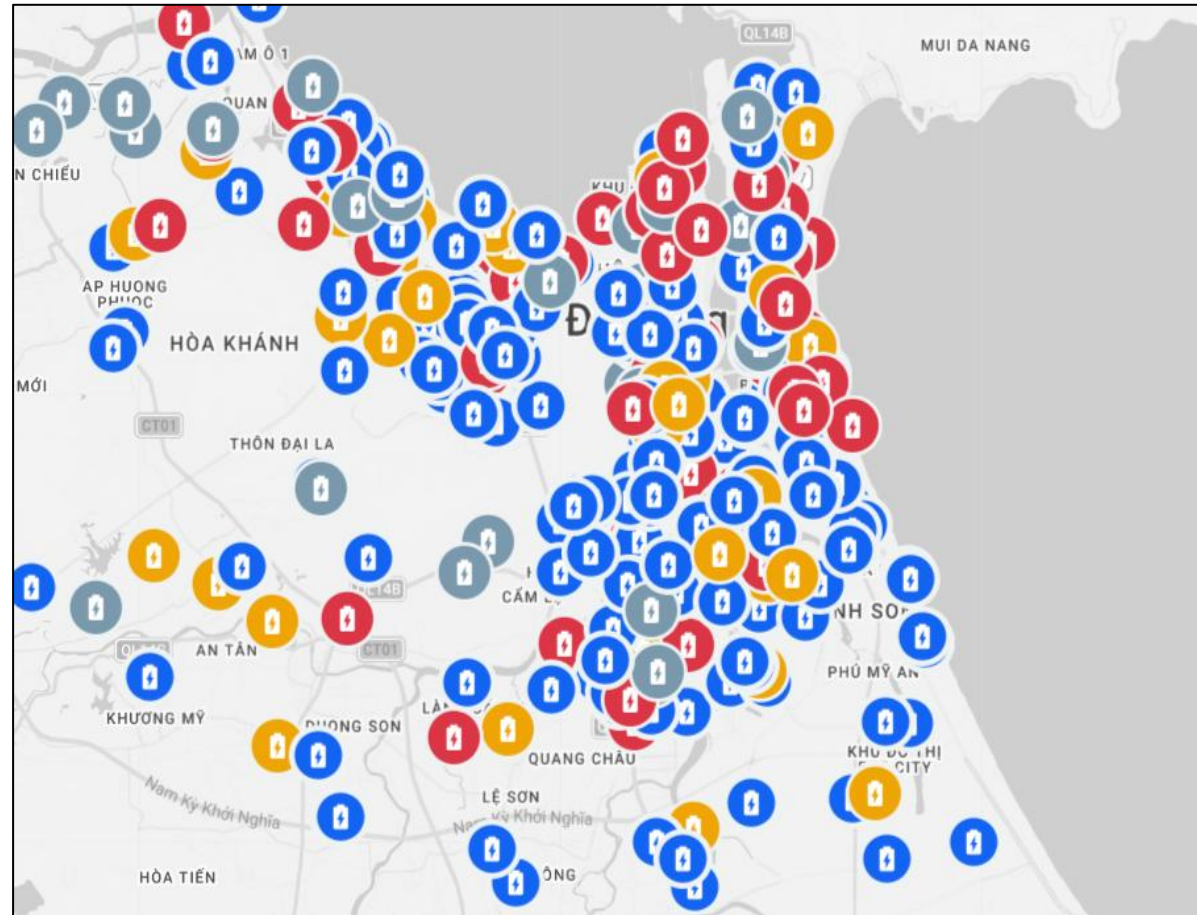

VinFast

- Part of Vin Group of companies founded by Pham Nhat Vuong in Ukraine in 1993
- Started by making instant noodles for Ukrainian market
- Sold dried food business to Nestle in 2009 for 150 million USD
- Started selling cars in Vietnam in 2019
- Went all electric in 2022
- Major player in SE Asia EV market
- Aspirations to become Global EV player
- Personal Observation - has about 95% Vietnamese EV market
- Many models from basic to luxurious
- Close ties to ruling Communist Party

VF 3

- 210 km range
- 4-seater Honda Fit size
- Starts from 13.5 K USD



VF 5

- 300 km range
- 5-seater Honda Civic size
- Starts from 22 K USD
- Popular with Rideshare drivers





What's next

- Move to EVs will continue to accelerate
- Vinfast will continue to dominate
- Other EVs will still be available but lack structural advantages of Vinfast
- No sign Tesla will enter market
- Electric scooters and motorcycles will increase market share
- Vinfast will aggressively expand in SE Asia
- Major headwinds in other parts of the World

FAST PAYOUTS vs. ANNUAL PAYOUTS

- Fast / Frequent Payout Options:
 - Monthly e-Transfer: Grizzl-E (\$10 minimum balance).
 - Direct Deposit at Milestones: SWITCH (every \$100 accumulated), DashSharing (\$100+ accumulated).
 - Quarterly Rewards: ChargeLab (gift cards / cash coming soon).
 - EFT Bank Transfer: Dashsharing: \$100 minimum

-  **Warranty & Support:** Does the host company offer accessible, Canadian-based customer support and strong hardware warranties?
-  **Host Company Track Record:** How long has the company operated, and can they reliably manage carbon compliance reporting?



Industry Challenges & Future Uncertainties

⚠️ WHAT LIES AHEAD FOR THE MARKET? FEDERAL CARBON CREDIT SYSTEM IN CANADA

-  **Carbon Trading Price Volatility:** Credit values fluctuate with supply and demand in carbon markets, directly affecting payout stability.
-  CFR Revenue Reinvestment Mandates: Rules requiring portion reinvestment into green infrastructure.
-  Manufacturer Credit Retention: Major networks (e.g., ChargePoint, FLO) claim carbon credits at the corporate level rather than sharing them with homeowners.
-  The Tesla Wildcard: Uncertainty remains over whether Tesla will claim residential Wall Connector carbon credits directly in future years.
-  Long-term Sustainability: Can high payout rates (\$0.10–\$0.18/kWh) remain sustainable as more EVs join the grid?

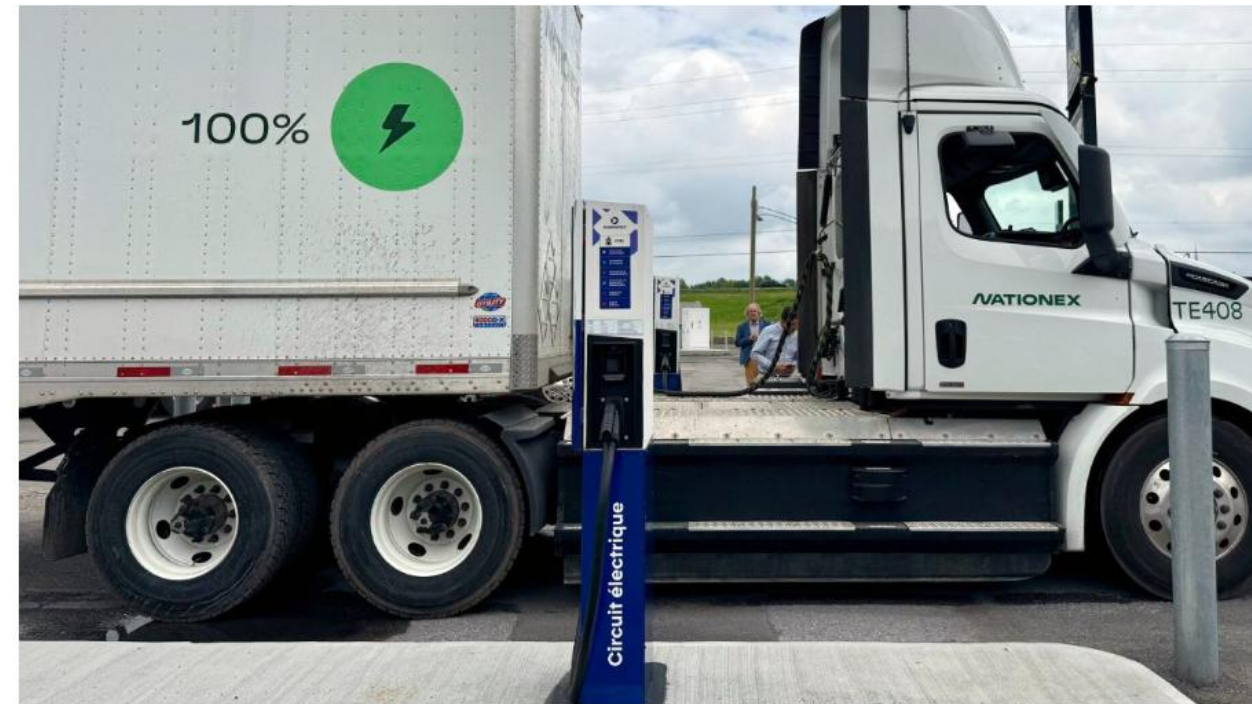
